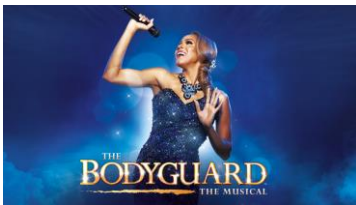

Space will be held on a tentative basis for 14 days after reserving a trip. We reserve the right to cancel your reservation if your deposit or final payment is not received by the payment date.

Daytrips: Full payment is due 45 days prior to the trip, and is Refundable up to 14 days prior to the trip

Daytrips with ticketed events (theatre, show, or ballgame): A \$ 75 per person deposit is required within 14 days of signing up to reserve your ticket. The balance is due 60 days prior to the trip and is Non-refundable unless your ticket is resold.

Multi-Day motorcoach trips: A \$ 75 per person deposit is required to reserve space. Balance is due 60 days prior to departure. Payments are refundable up to 60 days prior to departure.


Multi-Day motorcoach trips with ticketed events (theatre, show or ballgame): A \$ 100 per person deposit is required to reserve. Balance is due 60 days prior to departure and is non-refundable unless your seat is re-sold
